



Every hole is individual at Debert Golf Course

At the par 36 nine-hole Debert Golf Course, all the holes are individual — you usually can't see the other fairways — so it can seem like the people in your group are the only ones on the course.

The golf course, which opened in 2002, was created from a hardwood forest, making the golfing feel like you're part of nature. That's until you reach the licensed clubhouse, with a full kitchen, where the atmosphere is friendly and inviting. A driving range is also part of the facility.

Memberships are \$550, tax included, and junior memberships are available for \$250. The course is open to all. Green fees for nine holes are \$20 for non-members. Club rentals and carts are available.

The course is open from dawn to dusk from April to November. The owners are Art Fisher, Dan MacKay and Randy Webb, who is also the manager.
