Duncan's Pub and Bambino's Pizzeria are different eating experiences that share a commitment to fresh, quality food, good service and are operated by the same owner.

Jeff Bembridge started Bambino's 25 years ago, featuring hand-tossed pizza cooked in a stone oven. About 10 years ago he saw the opportunity to add something more. "I've always wanted a pub," he says. "I wanted some place where you could take your mother or wife."

The goal was to create a pub with a cozy atmosphere. And on Thursday and Friday evenings, in particular, when the pub features an open mike or live entertainment, Jeff knows people are comfortable when the mood is like a kitchen party.
