Gudi has sold her sausages at the Truro Farmer’s Market for more than 15 years. She often offers samples and has found that some people who wouldn’t usually eat sausages have become regular customers of Gudi’s Sausages. She offers seven varieties of sausages and two types of sauerkraut. “There is a sense of pride involved, when you can carry on some traditions of your home country and introduce these successfully at the same time.”
