Compared with pine, white cedar is eight times more decay and rot resistant when in contact with the ground. Plus, the wood contains oils that are natural insect repellents.

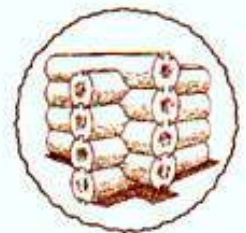
