A table's story

The creation of a nine-foot-long birds-eye maple table began with a conversation between the customers and Joseph Morrison (Photo 1).

“Over the next few weeks I started designing leg systems and tops and different styles of aprons,” says Joseph.

He made drawings and put together quotes. They talked about matching the table colour to chairs previously refinished.

Rough lumber was ordered, planed, cut, matched, glued, sized, cut again for width and length. Holes were drilled for leaf pins and aprons and walnut accent added (Photo 2).

After the pieces were sanded, stained and lacquered, the parts were assembled, checked and tweaked and then reassembled in the customer's home (Photo 3). “We take pride and we stand behind our work.”
